Quit stalling!

Uniline, located at Yatala, Queensland, is a leading Australasian company specialising in the manufacture and supply of world-class components and fabrics for the window furnishing industry.

As a long-term Sandpiper pump user, Uniline was recently looking to overcome a problem with some originally-supplied opposition-brand plastic diaphragm pumps used on the paint line for Venetian blinds. The pumps were stalling and leaking.

Uniline Maintenance Manager, Andrew Jackson, contacted Kelair's Sales Engineer, Rudi Jahrig to discuss what options were available to improve the pumps.

After investigating the chemical composition of the paint used, Rudi suggested the Sandpiper metal diaphragm pump as opposed to the plastic opposition-brand.

Sandpiper pumps are lube-free and the only air-operated diaphragm pump on the market with a "Non-stall" guarantee (in writing). Further, Sandpiper pumps are fitted with an externally serviceable air distribution system (ESADS+), eliminating the disassembly of the pump if the air system is worn.



Andrew trialled an S05 Aluminium Teflon pump and was so impressed that all the pumps on the paint line have been changed over to Sandpipers.

"Aside from the pumps working perfectly, the service from Rudi, who has looked after our plant for nearly 10 years, has been terrific. He constantly drops in to check how things are going, and is always available if we need advice," said Andrew.
